

Lake Geneva Symphony Orchestra 2019 Young Artist Competition

The Lake Geneva Symphony Orchestra invites young musicians to participate in its 2019 Young Artist Competition. The winner will be invited to perform with the LGSO in its 2019-20 season and awarded a \$750 scholarship to be used toward educational expenses. The following rules apply.

1. Contestant must be in high school or younger in the 2018-19 school-year.
2. Contestant must reside within 35 miles of Lake Geneva, Wisconsin during the school year. Distance will be determined by the shortest distance between the contestant's home address and 700 North Bloomfield Rd., Lake Geneva, Wisconsin, offered by a driving directions search using Google Maps.
3. Contestant must be prepared to perform one movement from a concerto in the standard orchestral repertoire, or a composition of similar stature with an orchestral accompaniment that is readily available.
4. The movement must not exceed 15 minutes in length.
5. Auditions will be performed with piano accompaniment. Contestants must provide their own accompanist.
6. The competition will be held on Wednesday, May 15, 6:00 – 8:00pm at Light Recital Hall in the University of Wisconsin Whitewater's Greenhill Center of the Arts (corner of Main and Prince). Each contestant will be given a 5-15 minute timeslot, depending on the length of the audition piece.
7. Memorization is not required, but is strongly recommended.
8. Contestant must furnish two copies of the solo part of the audition piece for the judges' use.
9. Auditions are not open to the public or the Contestant's family members.
10. Judges may elect to not award a scholarship, and LGSO may decline to extend an invitation to perform, if there is no audition of suitable quality, or if doing so would be detrimental to the interests of the LGSO or the Scholarship Fund.
11. Interpretation of these rules by the LGSO Young Artist Committee will be final.

The application deadline is Friday, April 19, 2019. The application fee is \$25. Send the completed registration form and a check payable to LGSO to:
